Fast App Switching - With iPhone 4's multitasking feature, these apps aren't actually running in the background (with the exception of certain apps such as audio stream or GPS lock). These apps, when not running, are being "frozen", such that when you reopen them, they are being restored to the exact state where you last close it.

App Folders - You can now sort your apps into folders.

iBooks App - With the latest iBook app (and an accompanying eBook store where you can download your favorite books onto your iPhone), you can now read them wherever you go.

Customized Backgrounds - You can now choose a persistent background for your iPhone (not just background for your lock screen).

If you already have an Apple iPhone (whether is it the latest iPhone 4 or the older versions – iPhone 3G or iPhone 3GS), you should check out the applications as well as the applications that are available online for the device.

Some of the popular applications to download onto your iPhone include:
