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## Short Coat & Beret Patterns for an 18-Inch Doll (#103)

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## MATERIALS

3 ply Fingering Yarn2 oz. YellowTwo No. 10 Knitting Needles.One Medium Crochet Hook.Two Buttons.

#### MEASUREMENTS

Chest 10 inches. Length of Coat from top of shoulder 6 inches.

#### TENSION

8 sts. and 10 rows – 1 inch (see note on tension on last page)

## The Coat

## BACK:

Cast on 71 sts.

1<sup>st</sup> Row: K1. \*P1. K1. Repeat from \* to end of row.

This row is worked throughout for the Moss st. Repeat

1<sup>st</sup>. Row 11 times.

13<sup>th</sup> Row: (K1. P1) 7 times. \*K3tog. (P1. K1) 8 times. P1.

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Repeat from \* once. K3tog. (P1. K1) 7 times. Repeat 1<sup>st</sup> row 11 times. **25<sup>th</sup> Row:** (K1. P1) 6 times. K1. \*P3tog. (K1. P1) 7 times. K1.
Repeat from \* once. P3tog. K1. (P1, K1) 6 times. (53 sts. on needle).

To shape armholes: Keeping continuity of Moss st. cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows,
