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Short Coat & Beret Patterns for an 18-Inch Doll (#103)

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MATERIALS

3 ply Fingering Yarn2 oz. YellowTwo No. 10 Knitting Needles.One Medium Crochet Hook.Two Buttons.

MEASUREMENTS

Chest 10 inches. Length of Coat from top of shoulder 6 inches.

TENSION

8 sts. and 10 rows – 1 inch (see note on tension on last page)

The Coat

BACK:

Cast on 71 sts.

1st Row: K1. *P1. K1. Repeat from * to end of row.

This row is worked throughout for the Moss st. Repeat

1st. Row 11 times.

13th Row: (K1. P1) 7 times. *K3tog. (P1. K1) 8 times. P1.

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Repeat from * once. K3tog. (P1. K1) 7 times. Repeat 1st row 11 times. **25th Row:** (K1. P1) 6 times. K1. *P3tog. (K1. P1) 7 times. K1.
Repeat from * once. P3tog. K1. (P1, K1) 6 times. (53 sts. on needle).

To shape armholes: Keeping continuity of Moss st. cast off 2 sts. beginning next 2 rows,
